## School Community Achievements/Accomplishments

- We have 3 Junior Scholars this year.
- We have 3 students approved for Early College .
- We had one student whose fishing team finished 3rd at the PBC Tim Kelley Memorial fishing tournament – the only middle school team in the state to place.
- 5 orchestra students made Region Orchestra in 2019.
- RLM donated over \$500 to the Children’s Cancer Partners of the Carolinas.
- 8th grade participated in the first ever “Simulation of Money” project with the support of the D2 District Office.
- The First Lego League team won an award for “Best Research Project” at the Carolina Isobots Tournament.
- RLMS collected over 4000 cans of food for the Upstate Family Resource Center.
- One 8th grade student was selected to the All State Orchestra; one of only 2 students in our district to qualify.
- The Beta Club took over 50 students to Myrtle Beach for the State Beta Club Convention.
- We had one 8th grade student that qualified for the State Geo Bee.

## Performance Results

### Strengths

#### 2019 scores

- School percentages for Meets plus Exceeds in English, Science, and Social Studies were higher than the state
- 48% of all students showed growth on the SC Ready state assessment.
- 70% of the students scored Met plus Exemplary on the SS PASS test
- 100% of the students passed the English 1 and Algebra 1 EOC

### Performance Goals

- Increase the number of students who pass the state test by 1% in each subject area
- Maintain 100% students passing the Algebra 1 and English 1 EOC
- Increase the number of perfect scores 1% on the Algebra 1 and English 1 EOC
- Increase growth in our lowest performing students by 1%
- Further enhance the digital transformation by continuing to increase meaningful integration during our instructional practice

- Conduct monthly TLT meetings with Chesnee Middle School and Boiling Springs Middle School.
- Maintain efforts to provide a high quality digital learning environment.
- Utilize devices to enhance classroom instruction, including Canvas, as a learning management system.
